Overview

This bill establishes a new civil cause of action for obstruction of a public highway.

Summary

Section Description

1 Highway obstruction; civil liability.

Establishes a new civil cause of action for obstruction of a public highway, effective August 1, 2025.

- **Subd. 1. Definition.** Provides a broad definition of "person" that includes individuals and other private or public entities. "Person" is the term used for a potential plaintiff in an action under subdivision 2.
- **Subd. 2. Civil liability imposed.** Imposes civil liability for damages—as well as attorney fees and costs—for anyone who obstructs a public highway.
- **Subd. 3. Relationship to criminal law; election of remedy.** Prohibits a state agency or political subdivision from pursuing *both* criminal prosecution and civil litigation under this section in response to the same action.
- **Subd. 4. Exemption.** States that this section does not apply to actions of law enforcement, other authorities/officials, or contractors thereof when they are acting within the scope of the law or a contract.
