



Subject Modifying MA Home Care Services

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# Overview

This bill adds care evaluation services as a covered service under medical assistance (MA) home care services, home health agency services, and home care nursing services. The bill also provides an unspecified payment rate increase for certain home care services and establishes a onetime grant program to support the implementation of activities focused on home care staff recruitment and retention.

# **Summary**

#### Section Description

#### 1 **Definitions.**

Amends § 256B.0651, subd. 1. Defines "care evaluation" in the section of statute governing MA home care services. Makes additional technical and conforming changes.

Makes this section effective January 1, 2026, or upon federal approval, whichever is later. Requires the commissioner of human services to notify the revisor of statutes when federal approval is obtained.

#### 2 Services covered.

Amends § 256B.0651, subd. 2. Adds care evaluations to the list of covered services under MA home care services and makes other clarifying changes.

Makes this section effective January 1, 2026, or upon federal approval, whichever is later. Requires the commissioner of human services to notify the revisor of statutes when federal approval is obtained.

# 3 Limits on services without authorization.

Amends § 256B.0652, subd. 11. Makes clarifying changes to the statute limiting MA home care services without authorization and adds care evaluations to the list of services a recipient may receive without authorization.

Makes this section effective January 1, 2026, or upon federal approval, whichever is later. Requires the commissioner of human services to notify the revisor of statutes when federal approval is obtained.

#### 4 Scope.

Amends § 256B.0653, subd. 1. Modifies the scope of home health agency services to include care evaluations.

Makes this section effective January 1, 2026, or upon federal approval, whichever is later. Requires the commissioner of human services to notify the revisor of statutes when federal approval is obtained.

# 5 Noncovered home health agency services.

Amends § 256B.0653, subd. 6. Makes a conforming change related to adding care evaluations as a covered service under MA home health agency services.

Makes this section effective January 1, 2026, or upon federal approval, whichever is later. Requires the commissioner of human services to notify the revisor of statutes when federal approval is obtained.

# 6 **Care evaluations.**

Amends § 256B.0653, by adding subd. 9. Specifies that MA covers care evaluations as a home health agency service provided that the recipient's home health services are not covered under Medicare or any other insurance held by the recipient. Sets the reimbursement rate for care evaluations at 300 percent of the MA reimbursement rate for a skilled nurse visit. Specifies when care evaluations must occur and who may provide care evaluations.

Makes this section effective January 1, 2026, or upon federal approval, whichever is later. Requires the commissioner of human services to notify the revisor of statutes when federal approval is obtained.

# 7 Care evaluations.

Amends § 256B.0654, by adding subd. 6. Specifies that MA covers care evaluations as a home care nursing service provided that the recipient's home care nursing services are not covered under Medicare or any other insurance held by the recipient. Sets the reimbursement rate for care evaluations at 300 percent of the MA

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reimbursement rate for a skilled nurse visit. Specifies when care evaluations must occur and who must provide care evaluations.

Makes this section effective January 1, 2026, or upon federal approval, whichever is later. Requires the commissioner of human services to notify the revisor of statutes when federal approval is obtained.

# 8 Rate increase for certain home care services.

Requires the commissioner of human services to increase payment rates for home health agency services, home care nursing services, and homemaker services provided under the elderly waiver by an unspecified percentage from the rates in effect on December 31, 2025.

Makes this section effective January 1, 2026, or upon federal approval, whichever is later. Requires the commissioner of human services to notify the revisor of statutes when federal approval is obtained.

9 Home care careers awareness building; recruitment and retention grant program.

Establishes a onetime grant program to support the implementation of activities focused on home care staff recruitment and retention.

**Subd. 1. Establishment.** Requires the commissioner of human services to establish a onetime grant program to support the implementation of activities focused on home care staff recruitment and retention.

**Subd. 2. Eligible grant recipients.** Makes licensed home care providers eligible for the grant under this section.

**Subd. 3. Allowable uses.** Lists the allowable uses of grant money under this section.

**Subd. 4. Distribution of grant money.** Requires grants to be distributed no later than January 1, 2026.

**Subd. 5. Report.** Requires grant recipients to submit a report to the commissioner that includes a description of how grant money was used by July 1, 2028.

**Subd. 6. Expiration.** Makes subdivisions 1 to 4 expire January 1, 2028, and makes this subdivision and subdivision 5 expire July 1, 2028.



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
