

**Subject** Student attendance  
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## Overview

This bill requires the Department of Education to post consistent attendance data for each school year no later than September 1 of the following school year and defines “consistent attendance.”

## Summary

Section	Description
1	<b>School performance reports and public reporting. [School accountability]</b> Requires the school performance reports posted by the Department of Education to include student attendance data for the previous school year.
2	<b>Consistent attendance. [School accountability]</b> Defines “consistent attendance” to mean a student attends more than 90% of school days while the student is enrolled at school. Requires a student to be enrolled for at least half an academic year to be included in a school’s calculation.  Requires the commissioner to post consistent attendance data for the 2024-2025 school year by September 1, 2025, and to subsequently post consistent attendance for each school year no later than the following September 1. Allows the commissioner to update the reported data after September 1.
